The MCC Material Resource Project for May is "Infant Care Kits"

Contents (new items only, size 3-9 months)

- 2 gowns/sleepers (flannel or similar warm, soft material)
- 2 undershirts/onesies (short or long sleeves)
- 4 cloth diapers (flat-fold preferred)
- 1 receiving blanket (lightweight fleece or flannel; minimum 36 inches)
- 4 safety pins (2 inches)
- 1 large bar mild soap (leave in wrapper)
- 1 pair of socks
- 1 cap

Remove the packaging material (except soap) and fold into the receiving blanket. Fasten together with the safety pins. Items can either be purchased or hand sewn. Finished kits may be brought back to church or dropped off at the Material Resource Center, 737 Hagey Center Drive, Souderton.
