Foundational command

Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one (Deut 6:4)

Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength (Deut 6:5)

Foundational communication

Impress upon your children (Deut 6:7)

When? All day, every day

Sit at home, Walk along the road, Lie down, Get up

How? By living and experiencing as a family

Talk, Tie, Bind, Write

Foundational commitment

Choice: Christ or cash/career/comfort
Matthew 6:19-24, 15:16-20

What flows from your heart? (Deut 6:6)

Implications

- Impossible to love God with all your heart and be lukewarm
 - Demonstrate a loving relationship with Jesus Christ
- Heart first, action second
 - To love God faithfully is to serve Him
