

Dig Deeper @Home – "Impress" Complement to sermon on September 11, 2016 – "Godly Legacy"

MEMORIZE – Titus 2:11-12

For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age

READ Titus 2: 1-10

Questions to ponder/discuss:

- 1. What is this passage revealing about God and what is it revealing about us as humans?
- 2. If the above is true, what needs to change in your life? What will that look like?
- 3. Paul tells Titus to "teach what accords with sound doctrine." In order to do this, we must possess sound doctrine. How is your doctrine? What steps can you take to make your doctrine more sound?
- 4. Why is it so important that Titus "show himself to be a model of good works" in all respects? What would happen if he wasn't a model of good works? Where do you show yourself to be a model of good works? Where do you need more strength from Christ to be a model of good works?
- 5. What does discipleship look like according to Titus chapter 2? Where can you apply this type of discipleship in your life?
- 6. Who do you know that is a generation older than you? Two generations? How about a generation or two younger? Have a conversation with them this week and see what you can learn from them about being a disciple of Jesus.

Experiential

Sometimes activities help us to understand and process biblical truths. The ones below are suggestions for how to experience the truths of Titus 2 and God's call for us to live fruitful lives. Feel free to use one of these or any you might come up with.

<u> Top 3</u>

Believe it or not, you spend the majority of time in three places. Analyze your day/week and determine your top 3 locations where you spend time. Last week you were encouraged to engage in prayer, care, share. This week, pray for each place you spend your most time. Pray for the people there. Ask the Lord to create opportunities for you to be a witness to Christ. Then every day, go expectantly, waiting to see what divine opportunity God will have waiting for you. Your top 3 aren't a coincidence. He has you there for a reason: to impress fruitful living and a godly legacy.
