

Dig Deeper @Home – "Return of the King" Complement to sermon on December 4, 2016 – "A Bold Declaration"

MEMORIZE – 1st Thessalonians 1:4

For we know, brothers and sisters loved by God, that he has chosen you, because our gospel came to you not only in word, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction.

READ 1st Thessalonians 2

Questions to ponder/discuss:

1. What is this passage revealing about God and what is it revealing about us as humans?
2. If the above is true, what needs to change in your life? What will that look like?

3. According to v7, how does God desire mothers to act toward their children?

- 5. Read v13 again. What does it mean that word of God is at work in you? What is evidence that the word of God is working in your personal life?

Experiential

Encourage One Another

This is a daily challenge for each day this week. Speak only things that will encourage (this means every situation) realizing that the encouragement we are to give is for Godly living. This means the encouragement may sometimes be partnered with correction. And there we find the beauty and power of encouragement; it is a much better way to offer correction than simply criticizing. But don't take our word for it. Find out yourself.

This is a time to gather around for prayer requests and to share how you have seen God at work. A time to hear where God is showing up in our lives and where we need Him to help us in our lives.

Sending prayer based on the lesson: Now may our God and Father himself, and our Lord Jesus, direct our way and may the Lord make you increase and abound in love, so that He may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father, at the coming of our Lord Jesus with all His saints.
