



## **Dig Deeper @Home – “Jesus is...”**

### **Complement to sermon on January 8, 2017 – “The Imprint of God”**

#### **MEMORIZE – Hebrews 7: 24-25**

But Jesus holds his priesthood permanently, because he continues forever. Consequently, he is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them

#### **READ Hebrews 2**

#### **Questions to ponder/discuss:**

1. What is this passage revealing about God and what is it revealing about us as humans?
  
2. If the above is true, what needs to change in your life? What will that look like?
  
3. What was the message delivered by angels? (hint: check out Acts 7:52-53 and Galatians 3:19)
  
4. What did the message by angels lead to? (hint: see verse 2)
  
5. In verse 1, the author of Hebrews is encouraging us to "pay closer attention to what we have heard."
  - a. What is he referring to? (hint: check verse 3 and 9-12)
  
  - b. What is the result when this message is received and followed? (hint: v4 & 14-18)
  
6. In v10 Jesus is referred to as the "founder" of our salvation. That word literally means champion.
  - a. What difference does it make that Jesus is the champion of your salvation (and not you?)
  
  - b. In what ways are you living like you are the champion of your salvation?
  
  - c. What would it look like in your life to recognize Jesus as the champion? Be specific

## **Experiential**

Sometimes activities help us to understand and process biblical truths. The ones below are suggestions for how to experience the truths of Hebrews 2. Feel free to use one of these or any you might come up with.

### **Arm Wrestling**

Have an arm wrestling tournament with a group. After you lose twice you are out. Do this until someone is crowned champion. How does this help you understand Jesus being the champion of your salvation?

### **Changing Lyrics**

For those who would rather not arm wrestle, listen to the song "We are the Champions" by Queen and re-write the song using the phrase "Jesus' the champion my friend." Have fun with it. Maybe you only re-write the chorus. If you are up to, try re-writing the verses as well. A good way to remember who the real champion is.
