Complement to sermon on June 25, 2017 – “Supernatural Proclamation pt 2”

MEMORIZE – 1st Kings 11:38

And if you will listen to all that I command you, and will walk in my ways, and do what is right in my eyes by keeping my statutes and my commandments, as David my servant did, I will be with you and will build you a sure house, as I built for David, and I will give Israel to you.”

READ 1st Kings 22

Questions to ponder/discuss:

1. What is this passage revealing about God and what is it revealing about us as humans?
2. If the above is true, what needs to change in your life? What will that look like?
3. Compare and contrast the opinions of Jehoshaphat Ahab in how they view receiving a word from the LORD through a prophet. (hint: verses 5-9)
4. Verses 15-28 detail Micaiah’s prophecies: one directed towards Ahab and one to the other prophets. How did the King and the prophets respond to Micaiah? How should they have? When God’s Word brings conviction to you, how do you respond?
5. Some kings, like Ahab, surrounded themselves with false prophets because they’d rather hear what they wanted than the truth. But are Old Testament kings the only ones guilty of this? Read 1st Timothy 4: 1-5. What do these verses say about false prophets? Who will acquire them? What is Paul imploring Timothy to do in response? What does this mean for followers of Jesus?
