Rise Against Hunger - Thanks for all who helped to package meals during our VBS *Rise Against Hunger* service project. We are delighted to announce that the 10,336 meals we helped to package have been shipped in a container totaling 285,120 meals from the RAH Philadelphia, PA warehouse. The meals will be received by their in-country partner Relief partner for distribution in the African country of Madagascar. Ninety-two percent of the population of this country lives on less than US \$2 a day. Some four million people - 28 percent of rural households - suffer from lack of food access. In Madagascar, RAH will be delivering 4,561,920 meals to support one lunch meal for 20,800 children attending 142 primary schools across the country.
