MEMORIZE – 2 Corinthians 1:20

For all the promises of God find their Yes in him. That is why it is through him that we utter our Amen to God for his glory.

READ – Read Romans 6: 1-14 & 8: 31-39

Questions to ponder/discuss:

1. What captured your attention in these scriptures?
2. What bothers you or makes you uncomfortable about these verses? Why?
3. What do these verses say about God?
4. What do these verses say about people?
5. If the above is true, what needs to change in your life?
6. Look through the passage and identify things that are written in past tense, things that are written in present tense and future tense.
7. Look again at Romans 8:34 and also 8:26. What encouragement do you get from these verses?

Experiential: More than Conquerors

In Christ, we are more than conquerors. How is this possible? Read Philippians 2: 12-13 and Paul tells us. God, Himself, gives us the desire and the ability to live a life that honors him. Take time and think of things that you currently do that you know are not in alignment with God. Perhaps it's living under a false identity, maybe it is fearing other people more than God, perhaps it's a heart of anger, impatience or lust. Take time each day this week and ask God to increase within you the desire and the effort to overcome this and walk in faithfulness.
