ICE BREAKER – ask these to open dialogue and learn more about those gathered

- 1. Share highs and lows of the past week.
- 2. When did you feel loved this week? When did you feel not loved?

MEMORIZE – 2 Corinthians 1:20

For all the promises of God find their Yes in him. That is why it is through him that we utter our Amen to God for his glory.

READ – Read Jeremiah 30:12 – 31:1 Questions to ponder/discuss:

- 1. What captured your attention in these scriptures?
- 2. What bothers you or makes you uncomfortable about these verses? Why?
- 3. What do these verses say about God?
- 4. What do these verses say about people?
- 5. If the above is true, what needs to change in your life?
- 6. According to 2 Corinthians 1:20, all the promises of Jeremiah 30:12-31:1 find their yes in Christ. Look again at each promise and dwell on how these are yes in Christ (and only in Christ). Does this understanding cause you to shift your expectation of these promises? In what way?

Experiential: The Love of Christ

It is one thing to know that Christ loves us it is another to receive His love. If we are honest, there are all kinds of reasons we can come up with to think we don't deserve God's love. And truthfully, we don't deserve his love. That's not the lie. But the refining truth is that our God is a God of love and mercy; And this changes everything. This means we can receive God's love not because we are worthy or deserving but because he is all merciful, all loving and full of grace. So, use the space below or in a journal write down all the reasons you tell yourself that you don't deserve God's love. Perhaps your actions, thoughts, attitudes, motives, secret sin, not so secret sin ... whatever it is, write it down. Then spend time reading and dwelling on 1st John 4: 9-14 and Romans 5: 6-11. Let these truths wash away the reasons you wrote down for why you don't deserve God's love. And as you go over each one, cross them out because God enables you to live free from them by the blood of Jesus Christ. After, use the songs below to spend time worshipping this amazing God of love.
