Green Pastures

Psalm 23 says that the LORD makes us lie down in green pastures. Hebrews 13: 1-19 are full of actions that would correlate to green pastures. Looking through these verses again, pick one verse to apply this week. Perhaps it is to show hospitality to strangers(v1) or to remember those in prison (v3) or one of the many others the author of Hebrews points out. Pick one and then live it out.
