READ Acts 17: 1-10

Questions to ponder/discuss:

1. What sticks out to you in this passage?
2. What did you like? What didn't you like?
3. What general observations can you make? Anything repeated? Contrasted? Compared?
4. What do you learn about the culture/context of Thessalonica from this passage?
 - a. What was the community's response to the gospel?
 - b. What might this tell us about the ongoing atmosphere for the church in Thessalonica?
5. What is this passage revealing about God?
6. What is it revealing about us as humans?
7. If the above is true, what needs to change in your life? What will that look like?

Experiential activity

Understanding the Culture

The church in Thessalonica existed within a culture and that culture has a response to the church (as we saw in Acts 17). Take time and reflect on the culture in which you live (neighborhood, work, school, the Northeast, USA). How is the church viewed? How is the gospel received? What is culture longing for and how can they find these longings met in the Kingdom of God? Once you discover this, you now know what “good news” sounds like. After you discover this good news, take time and share it with people as you go through your day.
