ICE BREAKER – ask these to open dialogue and learn more about those gathered

1. If you were a bird, which kind would you choose to be and why?
2. How do you respond to being corrected? Receiving negative criticism? Being held accountable?
Or having someone share constructive criticism?

MEMORIZE – Micah 7: 18-19

Who is a God like you, pardoning iniquity and passing over transgression for the remnant of his inheritance? He does not retain his anger forever, because he delights in steadfast love. He will again have compassion on us; he will tread our iniquities underfoot. You will cast all our sins into the depths of the sea.

READ Micah 2

Questions to ponder/discuss:

1. What sticks out to you in this passage?
2. What did you like? What didn't you like?
3. What general observations can you make? Anything repeated? Contrasted? Compared?
4. What is this passage revealing about God?
5. What is it revealing about us as humans?
6. If the above is true, what needs to change in your life or what truth from above do you need to apply in your life and how will you do that?

Experiential activity – Legitimate Children

Being confronted can be hard to take, even if it is correct and loving. It is hard to read Micah and not feel convicted. (If you aren't feeling convicted, go back and read again). But to put ourselves in the right posture to receive this correction, read Hebrews 12: 1-17 and then answer the following questions:

1. In what ways are you feeling convicted?
2. In what ways are you feeling comforted?
3. What is God calling me to do in light of these words?
