ICE BREAKER – ask these to open dialogue and learn more about those gathered

1. If you were a tree, which would you be and why?
2. What is your favorite part of Spring? What is your least favorite?

MEMORIZE – Micah 7: 18-19

Who is a God like you, pardoning iniquity and passing over transgression for the remnant of his inheritance? He does not retain his anger forever, because he delights in steadfast love. He will again have compassion on us; he will tread our iniquities underfoot. You will cast all our sins into the depths of the sea.

READ Micah 7

Questions to ponder/discuss:

1. What sticks out to you in this passage?
2. What did you like? What didn't you like?
3. What general observations can you make? Anything repeated? Contrasted? Compared?
4. What in your life right now has you feeling hopeless?
 - a. According to chapter 7, where is hope not found (but are places we look for it)? (hint: v1-6)
 - b. Where are the people told to look for hope? (hint: v7)
 - i. What difference does this hope make? (hint: v8-11)
 - ii. How does this hope effect the places you are feeling hopeless?
5. What is this passage revealing about God? How is Jesus the ultimate fulfilment of Micah 7?
6. What is it revealing about us as humans?
7. If the above is true, what needs to change in your life or what truth from above do you need to apply in your life and how will you do that?

Experiential activity – Have a worship service

Last week we identified idols in our hearts and brought them before the Lord. This week, we found what out what God does with those. Read again Micah 7: 18-20. In faith, receive the forgiveness that God offers through Jesus Christ. Receive by faith, the power of the Holy Spirit to live in victory over whatever idol/sin you identified in your hearts. By faith, believe that your idols/sins were hurled into the sea. Respond by having a time of worship, using the songs below or your own choice. As you worship, dwell on the forgiveness and the newness that is yours in Christ Jesus. We truly do serve a God like no other!
