



## **Dig Deeper @Home – “Jesus Alone”**

### **Complement to lesson on 10/24/21 – “The #1 Influencer to Follow”**

#### **ICE BREAKER – Questions to open dialogue and learn more about those gathered**

1. What people or groups do you follow and in what ways?
2. What are your responses to this quote, “If you can’t follow, you can never lead.” Email or text your response to Pastor Kris

#### **MEMORIZE – John 5:39-40**

“You search the scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; and it is they that bear witness about me, yet you refuse to come to me that you may have life.”

#### **READ – John 20:30 - 21:14**

#### **Questions to ponder/discuss:**

1. What does the Holy Spirit draw your attention to as you read these passages?  
What sticks out to you?
  - a. What details do you see? What details are left out?
  - b. Is anything repeated? Contrasted? Compared?
2. What do these passages reveal about Jesus?
3. John mentions a charcoal fire in 21:9 which perhaps seems like an unnecessary or strange detail to include. However, look up John 18: 15-20. With this in mind, what might be so significant about it being a charcoal fire that Jesus had on the beach for his disciples?
4. What is significant about Jesus sharing a meal with his disciples? If needed, take some time and research the importance of sharing a meal in the culture and context of Jesus’ day.
5. What do you make of Jesus causing the disciples to get such a large catch of fish even though he already had fish on the fire?

## **EXPERIENTIAL ACTIVITY – Host a Meal**

In this passage, Jesus shares a meal with the same group of people who had abandoned him and even denied him. Hopefully in your research, you discovered the significance of sharing a meal with somebody. This week, put this into practice by inviting someone from your neighborhood, your workplace or where you play over for a meal. Ask the Lord who He wants you to invite and then do it. Bathe the time in prayer, ask plenty of questions to get to know the people you are hosting better and enjoy the time of fellowship.
