ICE BREAKER – Questions to open dialogue and learn more about those gathered

1. Do you believe in coincidences? Why or why not?
2. Finish the sentence: what gives me greatest joy is ...

MEMORIZE – Acts 17: 6-7

... “These men who have turned the world upside down have come here also, and Jason has received them, and they are all acting against the decrees of Caesar, saying that there is another king, Jesus.”

READ - Questions to ponder/discuss:

1. Read Matthew 22: 36-40 and John 3: 17. God sent His son to die on a cross for all of humanity's sins, can we truly love God without sharing that truth?
2. Read Galatians 5: 19-24. Which life do we want to lead, one driven by flesh or the fruit of the Spirit? Do we want the same for everyone?
3. Read Ephesians 2: 8-10. If we have been created “for good works which God prepared beforehand” would God not also prepare us as well?
4. Read Esther 4:14. God’s will cannot be thwarted; the question is do we want to be a part of it? What keeps us from being part of it? How can we more intentionally join His will where we live, work, go to school and play?
5. Read 1 Peter 4: 10-11. God gave each of us gifts and places where we can use those gifts...why do we hesitate? What is your gift? How can you more actively and intentionally serve others with your gift?
6. Read Matthew 13: 1-9 & 18-23, and/or Mark 4: 1-9 & 13-20 and/or Luke 8: 4-8 & 11-15. If we are the sower and the seed is the Word of God (the Gospel), who gets the fruit? Just those we share it with? Or do we gain joy as well? If the Ephesians passage is true and God has prepared good works for each believer wouldn’t God also prepare good soil for us?

EXPERIENTIAL ACTIVITY – Pick One to Live Out

Below are some thoughts and quotes that have been meaningful to our guest speaker, Rich Longacre. Look them through and pick one that you will cling to and live out in a place where you hang out and play.
