## ICE BREAKER – Questions to open dialogue and learn more about those gathered

- 1. What is your favorite part of the Advent season?
- 2. What are your favorite color Christmas lights?

## MEMORIZE – Matthew 1:21

She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins.

### READ – Matthew 1: 1-17

#### **Questions to ponder/discuss:**

- 1. What does the Holy Spirit draw your attention to as you read these verses?
  - a. What particular words or phrases is the Holy Spirit highlighting to you as you read?
  - b. Is anything repeated? Contrasted? Compared?
  - c. What are the verses revealing about God? About people? In light of these, what needs to change in your life?
- 2. Why do you think Matthew opens up with a genealogy?
- 3. Genealogies didn't typically include women's names.
  - a. How many does Matthew include in his genealogy?
  - b. What do you know about any of these women?
  - c. What does it say that Matthew is willing to include these women in the genealogy?
- 4. Matthew opens and closes his genealogy highlighting Abraham and David in the lineage of Jesus. What is the significance of this?

## **EXPERIENTIAL ACTIVITY – Draw a Family Tree**

Matthew must have taken a lot of time to discover the family tree of Jesus. It covers 42 generations! Take some time and draw out your own family tree. How far back can you go? How well do you know the people of your own family tree? Enjoy making discoveries of your own background as you spend time creating your family tree.
