ICE BREAKER - Questions to open dialogue and learn more about those gathered

- 1. Would you rather lead yourself or be led by another? What circumstances could cause your answer to change?
- 2. Share a time when you felt led by Jesus.

MEMORIZE – Jeremiah 33:2-3

Thus says the LORD who made the earth, the LORD who formed it to establish it – the LORD is his name: "Call to me and I will answer you, and will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known."

READ – Read Psalm 23, John 10: 1-21

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Que	stions to ponder/discuss:
1.	Re-scan the text and consider
	a. What did the Holy Spirit cause to "jump off the page" as you read?
	b. Is anything repeated? Contrasted? Compared? (If so why might that be?)
	c. What are the verses revealing about God? About people? In light of these, what needs to change in your life? What are you already doing well?
2.	is my shepherd. David fills in the blank with "the LORD." What other "shepherds" want to fill that blank in your life? What other "shepherds" do fill that blank in your life? What would it look like for the LORD, (Father, Son & Holy Spirit) to fill that blank in your life? How do you know when the LORD is your shepherd and when something or someone else is?

- 3. Of all the promises in Psalm 23, which do you most need to experience right now?
 - a. Spend time praying to the Good Shepherd and ask Him to lead you in this way.

EXPERIENTIAL ACTIVITY – Don't Give the Enemy a Seat at Your Table
