

**Dig Deeper @Home – “Echoes of the King”**  
**Complement to lesson on 11/05/23 – “Go to Repair”**

**ICE BREAKER – Questions to open dialogue and learn more about those gathered**

1. If you could have any food truck show up to your house on a regular basis, which food truck would you choose?
2. What’s the last thing you repaired? How did it go?

**MEMORIZE – Mark 1: 14-15**

Now after John was arrested, Jesus came into Galilee, proclaiming the gospel of God, and saying, “The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel.”

**READ – Read Mark 1: 21-34, 40-45**

**Questions to ponder/discuss:**

1. Re-scan the text and consider...
  - a. What did the Holy Spirit cause to “jump off the page” as you read?
  - b. Is anything repeated? Contrasted? Compared? (If so... why might that be?)
  - c. What are the verses revealing about God? About people?  
In light of these, what needs to change in your life? What are you already doing well?
2. How many times do you see the word “immediately” in these verses? (Mark uses the word 41 times throughout the entire book)
  - a. Why does Mark use this word so regularly? What is the point? What is he conveying?
3. Compare the response of the demon to Jesus in verses 21-28 to that of the healed leper in verses 40-45. What is similar? What is different?
4. In the sermon, it was shared that all followers of Jesus are food truck operators for the kingdom and that food trucks all have their own territories. Your territory is where you live, work, study, worship and play. Spend time praying for people from those areas, asking God to show you how he is working in their lives and how you can join him in that work.

## **EXPERIENTIAL ACTIVITIES**

### **Receiving Healing from Jesus**

In these verses, Mark shares how Jesus provides healing and repair to people. Physical, spiritual, emotional healing. Spend time with Jesus this week, asking Him to bring you healing and repair. You can do this by yourself or with others.

### **Sharing Healing of Jesus**

Jesus went around and declared the good news of the Kingdom. Part of that good news is healing and repair. Who in your life (in the places you live, work, study, worship and play) needs to experience the healing and repair from Jesus? Ask the LORD to open your eyes to who needs this in these spaces and ask Him to help you share this with them. Be willing to share with them how you have experienced this healing and repair for yourself. In doing so, you are proclaiming the Kingdom and sharing the Good News.
