ICE BREAKER – Questions to open dialogue and learn more about those gathered

- 1. Have you or someone you know ever been asked to testify before a judge in court? Tell about that experience. What were you asked to do?
- 2. What testimony of faith have you heard recently that has inspired you?

MEMORIZE - 1st John 2: 5-6

"But whoever keeps his word, in him truly the love of God is perfected. By this we may know that we are in him: whoever says he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in which he (Jesus) walked."

READ - 1st John 5

Questions to ponder/discuss:

- 1. Read 1 John 5:6-12. Notice how many times the word "testimony" and "testify" are used in these verses. How many?
- 2. To what might the water and blood in verses 6 and 8 refer? (See Matthew 3:13-17 and Hebrews 9:12 for help.)
- 3. Name the three witness's testimonies which are in agreement.
 - a. How is each a witness?
 - b. How has God testified concerning Jesus? (Cf John 5:31-37)
- 4. What two kinds of people does John contrast in verse 10 and what is true of each? Why do you think it is such an offense to God for anyone to not believe the testimony of His Son?
- 5. According to 1 John 5:11-12, what is the key to eternal life?

EXPERIENTIAL ACTIVITY – My Testimony about Jesus

One of the most important things you can do as a Christian is to write out your personal testimony of your faith in Jesus. This exercise will help you think through in your own mind what God has done in your life and will prepare you to share your story simply and clearly with others.
