ICE BREAKER – Questions to open dialogue and learn more about those gathered.

- 1. What gift did you receive this Christmas that felt extra generous and special to you?
- 2. What gift did you give to someone else that you put a great deal of thought into before you gave it?

MEMORIZE – Ephesians 4:7

"However, he has given each one of us a special gift through the generosity of Christ" (NLT)

READ – Romans 12:3-8

Questions to ponder/discuss:

- 1. Re-scan the text and consider...
 - a. What did the Holy Spirit draw your attention to as you read?
 - b. Is anything repeated? Contrasted? Compared? (If so... why might that be?)
 - c. What in these verses is interesting? What is confusing?
 - d. What are the verses revealing about God? What are the verses saying about people?
- 2. Compare Romans 12:3-8 with 1 Corinthians 12:1-11 and Ephesians 4:7-16.
 - a. What do you notice?
 - b. What is consistent in all three texts regarding spiritual gifts?
 - c. What does this mean for you in your walk with Christ?
- 3. As you read over these three scriptures, which spiritual gifts stood out to you and which did you identify the most readily with from your own experience?
- 4. What do you think Paul means when he says we are to use our gifts "according to the measure of faith" (verse 3)?
- 5. How can we actively contribute to the building up of the church body, using our unique gifts?

EXPERIENTIAL ACTIVITY – Unpacking Your Spiritual Gifts

If you are interested in unpacking gifts God is giving to you, prayerfully follow the following steps.

- First Pray: Ask God to reveal your gifts to you and be open to how God leads you.
- **Re-read the scriptures:** Romans 12:3-8; 1 Corinthians 12:1-11; Ephesians 4:7-16
- Ask others: Ask people who know you well what spiritual gifts they see in you.
- **Begin to Serve right where you currently live, work and play**: Respond to needs and opportunities to engage both inside and outside the church
- Look for fruit: When you serve in your areas of gifting, you should expect evidence of God's presence and power.
