**Complement to lesson on 3/8/26 – “Building Altars”**

**ICE BREAKER – Questions to open dialogue and learn more about those gathered**

1. What is something you are impatient about?
2. Share a time when you waited on the Lord. Share a time when you didn't.

**MEMORIZE – Matthew 6: 32-33**

For the Gentiles seek after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them all. But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.”

**READ – Read Exodus 20: 18-26, Deuteronomy 27: 1-8, Psalm 34 & Revelation 12**

**Questions to ponder/discuss:**

1. Re-scan the text and consider...
  - a. What did the Holy Spirit draw your attention to as you read?
  - b. Is anything repeated? Contrasted? Compared? (If so... why might that be?)
  - c. What in these verses is interesting? What is confusing?
  - d. What are the verses revealing about God? What are the verses saying about people?
  - e. In light of these, what needs to change in your life? What are you already doing well?
2. What do you see connecting these 4 sets of scriptures together?
3. What was so important about altars? Why did God command them to be built? What is the relevance to Christians?
4. Pick a verse to meditate on. Keep bringing this verse to mind this week and invite the Holy Spirit into a conversation.

## **EXPERIENTIAL ACTIVITY – Meals as Altars**

According to the verses you read, several activities happen around an altar. Some of these include thanksgiving, worship/praise, sacrifice, eating, and remembering the LORD. In our culture, most of these happen around the table when we gather for meals. So make a point this week to highlight these aspects and connect your breakfast/lunch/dinner to God's people gathering around the altar. Something had to be sacrificed for your meal. Many start meals with prayers of thanks. To add the elements of worship/praise and remembering, take turns sharing where/how you and God adventured together that day. Perhaps open God's word and read scripture together and discuss what this reveals about who God is. Let's turn our meals this week into gatherings around altars and then continue this practice moving forward. Invite others to your table as well and let them enjoy the experience of meals as altars!
